## Two years in Ecuador

A few months ago, I returned from Ecuador where I spent almost two years doing my *Cross-Cultural Training Program (CTP)*. This program allows a student to spend time in a foreign country or a place inhabited by people of a culture different from the student's culture. Ecuador, the place of my CTP experience, is one of the smallest among Latin American countries. Located in the Northwestern part of South America, it is a home to some 14 million people. Rich in its cultural and ethnic diversity as well as abundant natural resources, Ecuador struggles with many socio-economic problems. In 1999, the country suffered a severe financial crisis. Due to hyperinflation and the change of the national currency from *sucre* to *dollar* the following year, many people lost their jobs and significant amounts of money. Nonetheless, the country strives to improve the conditions of its citizens by implementing many social and economic reforms.
